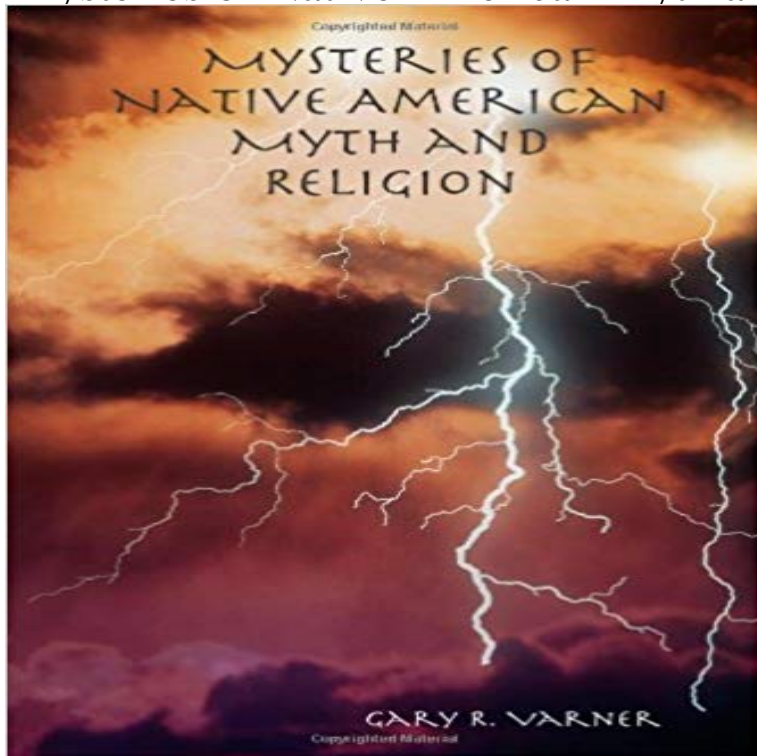


Mysteries of Native American Myth and Religion
